1. Introduction

- 1.1. The following report details figures for the financial year 1st April 2017 to 31st March 2018 for a number of local authorities initially identified using the CIPFA 'Nearest Neighbours' model. The following authorities provided figures for this benchmarking exercise:

Other comments provided by the relevant participating authority have also been detailed where appropriate.
