Benchmarking Report (Quarter Three Performance 2017/18)

1. Introduction

- 1.1. The following report details figures for the financial year 1st April to 31st December 2017 for a number of local authorities initially identified using the CIPFA 'Nearest Neighbours' model. The following authorities provided figures for this benchmarking exercise:
